

Advanced Photo Course Syllabus

Course Description:

This course will help students become well rounded in the fundamentals of digital photography. Students will engage in the appreciation and understanding of the fine art of photography. Advanced digital photographic skills, techniques and editing along with history, current art theory and photographic representation are emphasized. Students will have access to the classes DSLR's, though the amount on hand are limited.

The class prepares students who are pursuing professional photography careers focusing on architecture, commercial, fine arts, photojournalism, medical, scientific, museum, portraiture, printing, sales, and teaching.

At the end of this course, students will:

- Know how to use various features of the camera so they may have creative control of their photos.
- Be able to decide what type of lighting to use in a given situation to produce optimum results.
- See how photographic composition can make or break a photograph
- Understand how to use photo editing software to improve the overall appearance of the image

Students will, generally, receive instruction, demonstration, and see samples of the desired outcomes at the beginning of each assignment. Students will be allowed to leave the class for 15 minutes and take photos for their assignments, based on what they are learning.

Materials required list:

- Paper or spiral or composition notebook
- Pencil
- Creative ideas
- iPad/phone (for taking photos)
- Headphones- We do online tutorials. The classroom only has 6 on hand

Work policy:

All work is submitted via Schoology and graded one on one by the student and the instructor. Late work has a minus 10% penalty and is only accepted for 1 week after the due date.

Class Fee:

There is a **\$30** class fee. This needs to be paid ASAP. **\$7.50** if you are on free lunch and **\$15.00** if you are on reduced. This is an elective course; you don't have to take it... so if this is beyond your budget, you need to reconsider taking a class that cost less. Objectives:

- To learn to communicate and articulate ideas both visually and verbally.
- To encourage students to become independent thinkers who will contribute inventively and critically to their culture through the making of art.
- Learn digital camera operation.
- Digital image editing and manipulation
- Students will be aware that each work of art is a unique expression of the individual.

Expectations:

- Be on time. This is your job right now. Treat it as such. 1% deduction per tardy off your final grade.
- Be prepared to participate- Bring a pencil and other materials you need to class. The use of class time is key to meeting the due dates for projects.
- Students are not permitted to leave school campus during class time.
- Be respectful of yourself, others and the room.
- **No food or drink in the art room.** – You're in a room of expensive electronics.
- Cell phones will have a time and place in this class. Be respectful and mindful of this. Otherwise standard school rules apply.
- If a student take advantage of the 15 minutes taking photos, this privilege will be taken away on an individual base.
